Has Madonna Seen This?

Though she's been scrutinized and idolized by everyone from Norman Mailer to Madonna, some sides of Marilyn Monroe have escaped the public eye. A few are revealed in a forthcoming book, "Bernard of Hollywood's Marilyn," a collection of Monroe photos—most never published—by the late glamour lensman Bruno Bernard, the man some credit with discovering Norma Jean as an unknown model. The

book, due from St. Martin's Press in June, contains Bernard's insider reminiscences about MM, compiled by his daughter, Susan. They shed new light on the event many say led to her split with Joe DiMaggio: the 30-take attempt to film the "flying skirt" scene from "The Seven Year Itch" in New York, when DiMaggio stormed off while crowds ogled Monroe as her dress repeatedly billowed above her waist. ■
